Membership

The Club's membership year runs from 1st October to 30th September.

Renewal notices will be sent out ahead of the new club year and renewals must be received by the end of October, otherwise membership will cease.

Members may pay for their renewals by BACS (referencing your unique LOGIN) or by cheque/cash to the Membership Secretary.

Members are allowed to bring the occasional guest to use the Club's facilities at no charge. Guests who make too much use of the Club should be encouraged to become a member of the Club in their own right.

Your membership of Tring Squash Club means you will also be registered with England Squash and be covered by their insurance, as well as the Club's insurance. Registration should happen within 3 months of you joining the Club and includes receiving a regular copy of the "Squash Player" magazine. As an individual you can register as an individual to a club and the selected club with approve the request.

All players are advised to wear goggles and for juniors this is mandatory.

Facilities



We operate a secure Club House; you will need the fob to gain entry to the Club House

We have 4 Squash courts (1 Glass back) with a viewing gallery upstairs

The telephone number of the Clubhouse is 01442 826480 (not manned)

The bar is open 7 days a week and is run by volunteers on a rota basis. If you would like join the bar rota please contact Joni Duncan. The bar has a games room attached with a table tennis table, a pool table, a dart board and a wide-screen TV with BT Sports. The bar is open Monday to Saturday from 17:00 to 23:00 and on Sunday from 12:00.

The Bar/clubroom is available for private hire; please contact Mark Bullard or Joni Duncan.

Courts



We have 4 squash courts.

The courts are all bookable through our booking system which turns the court lights on when the session starts. (see later – PA court booking system)

Some courts will be reserved for events such as team matches or Club nights

Courts are available 7 days per week, 365 days per year

Courts are available from 05:20 to 23:40 daily

Court sessions are usually 40 minutes. Cost per court is £2.50 per 40 minute session during off-peak hours, and £3.80 per 40 minute session during peak hours. Peak hours begin at 18:00 daily. Court 2 is available for a 60 minute session at 20:00 each day and costs £5.60.

PA court booking system



The booking kiosk is located in the clubhouse at the far end of the squash court corridor.

The fob issued to you for entry into the clubhouse is also used to activate the kiosk.

You can access the court booking system through the Club's web site

Credit can be accrued in your member's account. You may add credit to your account using cash at the kiosk, by PayPal (there is a small fee from PayPal) through on-line access to the court booking system or by leaving a cheque (minimum £30) made payable to Tring Squash Club in the post box adjacent to the kiosk. Please note that PayPal fees are paid for by the member, not the club.

The kiosk takes the following coins:- £2, £1, 50p, 20p, 10p

You can book courts at the kiosk or on-line - if on-line, you must have enough credit in your account to cover the cost of the court.

Your Username and password for on-line access to the court booking system were provided to you in your welcome letter.

You can go on-line to the court booking system to change your password if you wish.

Instructions on using the kiosk are posted adjacent to the kiosk. Instructions for using the system on-line should also have been sent to you with this Welcome Pack.

If you can't use a court that you have booked, you can cancel your booking either at the kiosk or on-line. The cost of the court will be credited back to your account if the court is subsequently booked by another member.

If you lose the fob that was issued to you the membership secretary can replace it for £5.

Courts are available for booking up to 2 weeks ahead. Courts 2 and 3 are made available for booking 14 – 21 days in advance on a Monday. Courts 1 and 4 are released daily for booking 14 days ahead.

If you have an e-mail address recorded on your membership record, the system will send an e-mail to confirm your booking.

Adjacent to each court door is a courtside controller that shows who currently has the court booked and how much time is left. You may use your fob - as long as you have sufficient credit – to activate court time in 8 minute increments any time the court is not booked. Simply press your fob onto the reader on the courtside controller and when the message “*** fob accepted ***” appears, remove your fob immediately and the court lights should go back on. You will be given an extra 8 minutes and your court credit will be debited with a pro-rata'd amount for the time used against the prevailing court cost.

Club members are limited to 1 peak time court per week until the sheets have been up for 7 days
